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CIRCULAR

Principals of all Colleges

Dear Sir/ Madam

It has already been decided by the Competent Authority that the admission process for students with disabilities for the year 2013-14 under Four Year Undergraduate Programme has been decentralised in order to promote inclusion and sensitivity in the colleges. In additions to the guidelines circulated by the University from time to time, you are requested to also strictly follow the following guidelines with regard to admissions of students with disabilities to various undergraduate courses:

- Three percent (3%) seats in all undergraduate courses are reserved for candidates with physical disabilities (not less than 40% of disability). The 3% reservation will be allocated as follows: 1% for persons with low vision or blindness; 1% for hearing impaired; 1% for those with locomotor disabilities and cerebral palsy. However if sufficient candidates are not available in a sub-category then candidates from other sub-categories should be considered in their place.
- Certificate of physical disability issued by chief medical officer/ civil surgeon of district or any government hospital authorised to give such certificate under the provisions of PWD Act 1995 will be considered for admission. - Every college will prepare a separate cut off list course-wise and of each disability in order of merit.
- The colleges must provide separate dedicated assessable space to deal with the process of admission of students with disabilities.
- The colleges must make a provision of help desk exclusively for students with disabilities.
- The colleges must provide adequate number of NSS/ NCC students to support the students with disabilities during admissions.

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
